

PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER LICENSE NCEES FUNDAMENTALS OF ENGINEERING (FE) EXAM

Please take the time to read this VERY IMPORTANT information about the Fundamentals of Engineering Exam as the format changed Jan 2014.

You are eligible to take the FE Exam, **if** you are a SENIOR in your last semester, with 20 hours or less to take.

If you meet this criterion, you no longer need NYS approval prior to taking the exam. To sit for the exam you must register and pay on the NCEES website at: www.ncees.org

The new CBT exam will be offered through the Pearson VUE's network of professional testing centers during four testing windows throughout the year: January–February, April–May, July–August, and October–November.

The Buffalo center is located at 325 Essjay Road in Williamsville. Registration will be open year-round.

After taking the exam, you will receive an email in 7 to 10 days advising you of the results of the FE exam.

To obtain your Intern Engineer Certificate you need to submit the following two forms after your undergraduate degree has been conferred:

Form 1IE – Application for Intern Engineer Certificate

This form must be submitted directly to the Office of Professions in Albany together with a \$70 fee.

Form 2 – Certification of Professional Education

This form must be submitted to the Student Response Center, Attn: Certification Dept. Fill out side 1 only; there is a sample copy in 410 Bonner if you need help in filling it out.

In NYS, an Intern Engineering certificate is required in order for you to put E.I.T or Intern Engineer after your name. If you have further questions please come to 410 Bonner for assistance.
